QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School graduate or equivalent required.
- Faculty teaching general education courses must have a baccalaureate degree with appropriate coursework in the subject area(s) taught.
- Must be a graduate from an accredited program.
- Must demonstrate training in educational methods, testing and evaluation and evidence strength in instructional methodology, delivery and techniques as indicated by evaluation personnel within 30 days of beginning instruction.
- California licensure or registration to practice as a pharmacist or pharmacy technician required.
- Certification by the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB) preferred.
- Must hold an active membership in a national pharmacy organization and the corresponding state affiliate.
- Must have a minimum of three (3) years of operating room experience or three (3) years of teaching experience in the field, or a combination of the two, within the last five (5) years.
- Must have a minimum of one (1) year of teaching experience in the subject areas taught or demonstrate prior training in instructional methodology and teaching skills from a formal teacher, educational program or any comparable training program or formal in-house training program.
